IOWA INSTRUCTION 230-380 – 2000 AND 2007 CENSUS ESTIMATE STATISTICS TO BE INCLUDED IN THE 230-15-11 FILE

1. PURPOSE:

This Iowa Instruction provides and distributes the 2000 and 2007 census estimate statistics to all offices.

2. BACKGROUND:

The Iowa Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Civil Rights Advisory Committee (CRAC) provides direction and guidance related to Civil Rights Compliance Reviews conducted across the state. A component of a Civil Rights Compliance Review includes reviewing all 230 files for complete and accurate information. One of the items required in the 230-15-11 file is current demographic data for the county or counties served by the field office or RC&D.

3. PROCESS:

The most current census information (and 2007 estimates) for each county in Iowa can be found at <http://quickfacts.census.gov/qfd/states/19000.html>. Each office should print the census report for the county or counties served and place it in the 230-15-11 file. This link can be used for future demographic updates when available. Each office should check this website annually for updates to print and file.
