


SOIL ASSOCIATIONS *

- 1 Hastings association: Nearly level to moderately sloping, deep, silty soils on loess-mantled uplands
- 2 Holder association: Nearly level and very gently sloping, deep, silty soils on loess-mantled uplands
- 3 Coly-Cozad association: Gently sloping to steep, deep, silty soils on upland breaks to the Platte River Valley
- 4 Hord association: Nearly level, deep, silty soils on stream terraces
- 5 Thurman-Meadin association: Nearly level to gently rolling, deep, sandy soils and shallow, sandy soils over mixed sand and gravel on stream terraces
- 6 Platte-Leshara-Alda association: Nearly level and very gently sloping, shallow to deep, loamy soils over mixed sand and gravel on bottom lands of the Platte River Valley

* Texture refers to surface layer of major soils in each association.
