


# GENERAL SOIL MAP

## PAWNEE COUNTY, NEBRASKA



### SOIL ASSOCIATIONS \*

- 1** Wymore association: Deep, nearly level to gently sloping, silty to clayey soils on loess-capped uplands
- 2** Pawnee-Mayberry-Burchard association: Deep, nearly level to moderately steep, loamy and clayey soils on glacial uplands
- 3** Kennebec-Judson-Wabash association: Deep, nearly level to gently sloping, silty and clayey soils on bottom lands
- 4** Benfield-Kipson-Sogn association: Moderately deep and shallow, gently sloping to very steep, silty and clayey soils on shale and limestone uplands

\* Texture refers to the surface layer of the major soils in each soil association.
