	<sup>2</sup> Practices are eligible on irrigated acres that are converting to non-irrigated.	
	<sup>3</sup> These practices are eligible for a higher payment rate if they are a practice used in conversion to non-irrigated grassland.	
	<sup>4</sup> Eligible only if producer is reducing water use by installing a three year crop rotation (three crop type minimum).	
	<sup>5</sup> This practice will be installed for the entire crop rotation or contract length, whichever is longer; a minimum three crop type rotation will be installed.	
	<sup>6</sup> Financial assistance is authorized when this practice is installed for conversion from irrigated cropland to non-irrigated cropland system on at least 40 percent of the application acres. Payment is only authorized on the converted acres and must be taken for three years.	
	<sup>7</sup> Financial assistance is authorized when the practice is installed for conversion from irrigated cropland to non-irrigated grassland on at least 40 percent of the application acres. (Planting will meet NRCS practice code 512 standards and specifications). Payment is only authorized on the converted acres and must be taken for three years.	
	<sup>8</sup> Financial assistance is authorized when the this practice is installed for conversion from irrigated cropland to non-irrigated grassland on at least 40 percent of the application acres. (Planting will meet NRCS practice code 550 standards and specifications). Payment is only authorized on the converted acres and must be taken for three years.	
	<sup>9</sup> This is a one time payment for the period of adoption. Practice will be implemented a minimum of three years. Payment will be made upon initial implementation of the practice on all contracted acres.
