**Subject: Proof of Insurance and Liability of the Government**

Please be advised that when this vehicle is operated by an employee of an agency of the United States Department of Agriculture on official business, or by an authorized employee of a State Conservation District in furtherance of official Federal Government business, all issues with respect to liability for this vehicle are governed by federal law. The United States Government does not maintain any private insurance on its vehicles, but rather is completely self-insured with any claims against the United States Government backed by the full faith and credit of the United States, with claims payable under the Federal Tort Claims Act, 28 USC § 2671 *et seq.*

The Federal Tort Claims Act, 28 USC § 2671 *et seq.*, provides for the exclusive remedy for any party who may be injured as the result of an action of a Federal Employee and any claim for damages arising from the acts of a Federal Employee must be processed according to the provisions of the Federal Tort Claims Act. This Act applies to all agencies of the United States Department of Agriculture.

Some states require that operators maintain adequate proof of insurance in the vehicle. This document provides that necessary proof. I am providing this information in my capacity as Regional Attorney for the Central Region, Office of the General Counsel, United States Department of Agriculture.

Please contact the Administrative Officer of the Federal Agency which employs the operator of this vehicle if you have any additional questions or concerns. If further legal advice is required, that Agency will contact me.
