SUBPART C – EVALUATION OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

WA512.23(c)

WA512.21(b) Evaluation Procedures

- (1) Used material is not be allowed for the application of NRCS engineering practices in the following cases:
 - i. Utilized as part of an individual NRCS Practice or;
 - ii. as a component of a NRCS Conservation Practice System.

- (2) The following exceptions to this policy shall apply. Used material is allowable in the following cases:
 - i. Where used material has been refurbished or rehabilitated by a company or vendor in that particular business and;
 - ii. The vendor provides a certification of suitability for the intended use and;
 - iii. the refurbished or rehabilitated product meets or exceeds the NRCS practice design life and;
 - iv. complies with the applicable NRCS practice standard(s) and specifications.

- (3) Written documentation of the evaluation and approval of the used material to be installed will be developed and approved by a NRCS employee with the appropriate Job Approval Authority for the design of the NCRS Practice of Conservation Practice System.

WA512.23(c) Prequalification of Materials

It will be the standard practice in Washington State not to develop or maintain a State list of pre-qualified materials.
