

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF WASHINGTON CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATION (CS-12)

EXCAVATION, ROCK

1. Applicability

Construction Specification CS-12 is applicable to all rock excavation. It may apply to the excavation of core trenches, emergency spillways, outlet channels, supply channels, ditches, pipe trenches, surface drains, and of other excavation where the material is defined as rock. This specification and Construction Specification CS-11, Common Excavation are NRCS classifications for excavation.

2. Material Specifications

There are no material specifications complementary to Washington State Construction Specification CS-12.

3. Special Items to be Included on the Drawings:

- a. Location, configuration and limits of excavation including borrow sites.
- b. The surface finish requirements.
- c. Boring or test pit logs pertinent to all areas to be excavated, if subsurface information is available. Test logs shall include water table elevations and dates.
- d. The location and limits of areas where the material may be used, if applicable.
- e. The location and limits of waste disposal areas, if applicable.
- f. The location and limits of the utility right-of-way or easements, if applicable.
- g. Special requirements for dewatering, if applicable.
- h. Special requirements for blasting, if applicable.
- i. Special requirements for control of erosion, sedimentation, water pollution and air pollution.
- j. Specify method measurement and payment, if applicable.
