To cancel Idaho Amendment ID12, Part 420 – Safety and Health Management Program, Subpart A – General.

To cancel Idaho Amendment ID26, Part 420 – Safety and Health Management Program, Subparts O – Safety Requirements for Incidental Motor Vehicle Operators and ID-O – Exhibits.

To cancel Idaho Amendment ID54, Part 420 – Safety and Health Management Program, Subpart S – Fitness/Wellness Program.
